WITHDRAWAL/REFUND POLICY

You may drop courses online through MyCSUEB, or submit your request to Continuing Education either by e-mail, letter, or using the Withdrawal and Refund Form. Failure to drop a course online, or file a written request to withdraw, before the end of the drop period may result in a failing grade (drop dates vary by program). Please note that a stop payment order on a check does not constitute an official withdrawal, nor does it relieve the student's financial obligation for the course.

If Continuing Education cancels a class, you will automatically receive a full refund. Refunds will be issued in the same form as payment received. Processing takes approximately six weeks.

Some Continuing Education programs have course-specific refund policies that supersede the refund policy below. The most common of these policies applies to most of our online courses and home study courses, and states that no refund will be given once a student has been given access to the online course. Course-specific refund policies are noted in the quarterly course schedule.

Refunds are based on the duration of the class and the date the refund is submitted online. Refunds for independent study and individual study are counted from the first day of the quarter, regardless of the actual registration day. Materials fees are non-refundable.
